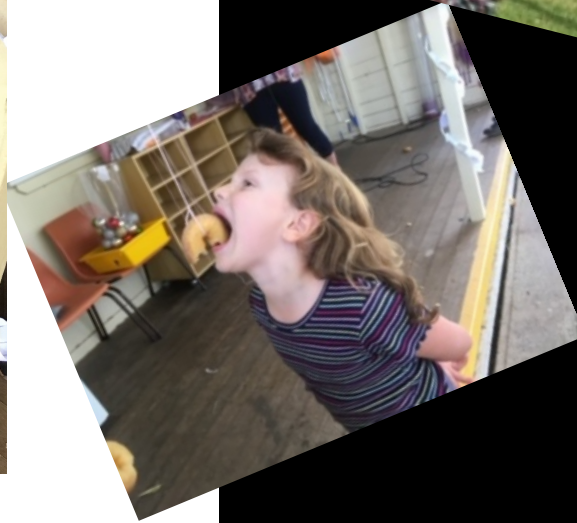
Thursday 21 November, 9.30-12noon - Students to bring a packed lunch/Parent information session.
