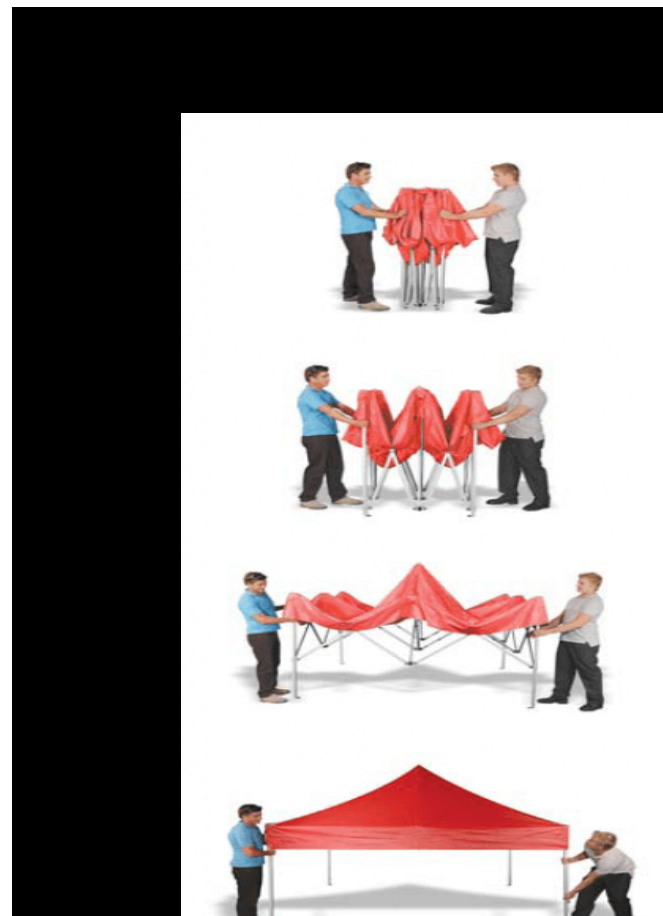


TENDER
